The book concludes with a chapter summarizing all chapters and

providing an holistic perspective of change processes.

The continuing development and the increasing use of the geostationary orbit has now created the need for a new, more detailed publication to include new aspects that have emerged. The present Handbook contains several additional subjects and more mathematics to describe the methods applied in PEPSOC. The geophysical and astronomical parameters have been updated to reflect the latest recommended values. This results in small deviations of the numerical data compared to the Introduction.
